Prompt: **TO WHAT EXTENT** did the **AMERICAN REVOLUTION** FUNDAMENTALLY CHANGE AMERICAN
SOCIETY? In your answer be sure to address the **POLITICAL**, **SOCIAL**, and **ECONOMIC EFFECTS** OF THE
REVOLUTION in the period from **1775-1800**.

ESSAY TASK: You will need to **QUANTIFY** the amount of change, and **JUSTIFY** it with your use of documents and OI (outside information), as well your interpretation of them (also known as **ANALYSIS**). You will need to present balanced treatment of each of the three subcategories. Limit your discussion to the period of 1775-1800.

Introductory paragraph: You set the stage here, preferably using a quote, anecdote or example to lay the groundwork for your thesis. Your thesis should come at the end of the paragraph and should provide a specific response to the prompt, addressing all of its complexity. This may require more than one sentence. In this case, I want to see you address the amount of political, social, and economic changes specifically. Remember that there can be different amounts of change for each of these subcategories.
